Applications from trainee surgeons should include a full CV, training log numbers, and an outline of the desired training objectives. If specific units are identified by the trainee as being particularly desired then these wishes will be considered.

Units wishing to host such fellowships should submit expressions of interest together with an outline job description for the post offered. The host Trust must be prepared to support these applications and applications from joint units are encouraged if this enhances the educational value of the post."

Applications from Fellows and units are required by 6 July and final decisions will be completed by the Educational subcommittee by 27 July.
