Towards M40 Junction 2, Farnham Royal, Farnham Common, Beaconsfield

By Road – from M40: Leave the motorway at J2. Follow signs to Slough, then either turn right into Montrose Avenue and follow the road around into Perth Avenue, or turn right into Edinburgh Avenue just after Pets at Home, then turn right again into Perth Avenue.

By Road – from M4: Leave the motorway at J6. Follow signs to Slough Trading Estate, joining the A355. Turn left into Edinburgh Avenue just after Selco Builders Warehouse, then right into Perth Avenue.
